NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION

**Class Environmental Assessment
Historic Maple Storm Drainage Improvements Study**

Based on study findings and the public and agency comments received, the City of Vaughan intends to plan the implementation of the improvements to the storm drainage system in the Historic Maple community. The City proposes to carry out works based on an assessment of low, medium and high priority projects. These works include minor improvements such as ditch/culvert cleanout to substantial exercises such as analysis of the main conveyance system for possible hydraulic improvements. The project was phased into three components: Preliminary Study and Background Review; Detailed Analysis and the Preparation of an Engineering Report with Detailed Solutions (if required).

The project is being planned under **Schedule A of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment** for Road Projects, which is an approved process under the Environmental Assessment Act. The study area is available for viewing on the City's website at www.vaughan.ca, under Public Meetings.

Copies of the Engineering Report which documents the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process for this project are available for viewing in the City's Clerk's Department at 2141 Major Mackenzie Drive.

Interested persons should provide written comment to the study consultant within 30 calendar days from the date of this Notice. If pertinent concerns regarding this project cannot be resolved in discussion with the municipality, a person may request that the Minister of the Environment make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act (referred to as a Part II Order), which addresses individual environmental assessments. Requests for a Part II Order must be received by the Minister of the Environment, 135 St. Clair Avenue, 10th Floor, Toronto, ON M4V 1P5, within 30 calendar days of this Notice. A copy of the request must also be sent to the consultant for this project. If there is no comment or request received within the 30 day period, the project may proceed to design and construction as presented in the planning documentation.

NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS TO DESTROY NOXIOUS WEEDS

Notice is hereby given to every person in possession of land within the City of Vaughan that all noxious weed or weed seeds shall be destroyed by June 1, 2008. Throughout the season the municipality, in accordance with the Weed Control Act, Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1990 Chapter W5 Section 3, 16, 22 and 23, may enter upon said land to cause the noxious weeds or weed seeds to be destroyed. This will be charged to said lands; if not paid, will be placed on property owners' taxes.

In the interest of public health, noxious weeds that require eradication are thistles, ragweed, goats beard, poison ivy, wild carrot, etc. Please note that dandelions, burdock and goldenrod are not considered noxious weeds with the City of Vaughan, therefore, complaints regarding these weeds cannot be accepted. However, the cooperation of all citizens is solicited in the elimination of all nuisance weeds. The City of Vaughan now bans the use of chemicals to destroy weeds or weed seeds.
